

CinemaSafe: Your Safety Is Our Focus

- **Masks Required** All employees must wear a face covering or mask. Patrons must wear a face covering at all times, except when eating or drinking. Those who are unwilling to wear a face covering will be denied entry.
- **Reduced Capacity & Social Distancing** Theater capacity is reduced to minimize number of patrons in the auditorium. Appropriate physical distancing must be maintained at all times between patrons, except members of the same household or those that attend together. We have a reduced seating capacity, and seats are blocked off using the “checkerboard” system to maintain a 6-foot distance.
- **Frequent Hand-washing** Employees have been trained on hand-hygiene practices, and are required to wash hands frequently at easily-accessible hand-washing facilities.
- **Air Filtration** Air scrubbers have been installed. [Click to read about air scrubbers](#)
- **Hand Sanitizer** Hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol (EPA approved ethanol or isopropyl) liberally placed in easily accessible public areas and patrons are encouraged by staff and appropriately placed signage to practice hand hygiene.
- **Enhanced Cleaning** Auditoriums are carefully disinfected between screenings. High-touch surfaces are wiped down regularly with EPA-registered disinfectant.
- **Modified Concessions** Communal food and condiments that require shared serving utensils or equipment have been eliminated.
- **Online Ticketing** Tickets are available online to reduce the need to stand in line for tickets. Alternatives to paper tickets are used whenever possible.
- **Not Feeling Well? Stay home.** If you are experiencing a fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, or other symptoms that could be related to COVID-19, please stay home and we welcome you to join us again in the future.
